International Class action against WOW Air and Azores Airlines – Compensation for Long Flight Delays

Champlain Avocats (Montréal, Québec) and Evolink Law Group (Burnaby, British Columbia) are counsel in a proposed international class action against WOW Air and Azores Airlines (also known as SATA Airlines) before the Federal Court of Canada.

This proposed class action is on behalf of passengers anywhere in the world who, on or after August 14, 2012, travelled on a flight to or from Canada operated by WOW Air or Azores Airlines and arrived at their destination more than three hours late. The class action seeks compensatory damages against WOW Air and Azores Airlines for failure to pay cash compensation of €300 - €600 to each passenger, as required under European flight passenger regulations and the airlines' own contracts of carriage.
